1809.1. No Apologies as all Councillors present

The Chairman asked Cllr Forrest to investigate how GDPR relates to Parish Councils.

1809.9. To consider any other matters brought to the meeting

- a) Water on Road nr Davis Gate: Cllr Hopwood advised that she was concerned that there might still be water getting onto the road from the houses opposite Davis Gate. It was agreed to wait until there had been more heavy rain before reporting this.
- b) Blocked drains in Gallows Lane. The clerk was asked to report that the drains are still blocked in Gallows Lane and that when there is heavy rain this causes a lot of debris to be washed down the road.
- c) Width of Footpaths & fencing Cllr Parker enquired if landowners are permitted to fence footpaths to stop dogs straying. The Chairman said one can fence in a footpath and that 1.5m width was required.
- d) Litter Bin in Gallows Lane: Cllr Forrest reported that the litter bin at the south end of Gallows Lane is not being regularly emptied. This can also encourage flytipping. Clerk was asked to report this to RVBC with the suggestion that a wheelie bin might assist with this problem. (Chairman provided a photo after the meeting)
